

NON-RESIDENT STUDENT ANNUAL REQUEST FOR ADMISSION TO WEST VALLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT

West Valley School District Policy 3141 (RCW 28A.225.330): Non-resident Students
Washington State Law provides that a district may reject a non-resident student if:

- a. Acceptance of a non-resident student would result in the district experiencing a financial hardship;
- b. The student's disciplinary records indicate a history of convictions for offenses or crimes, violent or disruptive behavior, or gang membership;
- c. The student has been expelled or suspended from a public school for more than ten consecutive days. Any policy allowing for readmission of expelled or suspended students under this subsection must apply uniformly to both resident and non-resident applicants. For purposes of this section, "gang" means a group which consists of three or more persons; has identifiable leadership; and on an ongoing basis, regularly conspires and acts in concert mainly for criminal purposes.
- d. The district shall provide to applicants written notification of the approval or denial of the application in a timely manner. If the application is rejected, the notification shall include the reason or reasons for denial and the right to appeal under RCW 28A.225.230.

Athletic Eligibility:

If the student is planning on participating in inter-scholastic athletics, the student must contact the school's athletic director for eligibility criteria.

Agreement:

It is understood that we, as parents, must assume responsibility for adequate transportation and supervision to and from school. We also certify that we have read and agree to the terms of West Valley School District Board Policy 3141 relating to the admission of non-resident students.

I understand that students requiring special education services on a current IEP will only be admitted if approved by both the sending and receiving districts' Directors of Special Education, and that the sending district agrees that tuition may be charged to the sending district to cover excess special education costs.

If this request is approved, I understand that the student named above will be subject to and will comply fully with the same school and school district rules and regulations as other district students. Students are required to have: (Parents need to initial the following)

- _____ Prompt & regular attendance/No excessive absences or tardies
- _____ Academic Achievement/No F's in any class
- _____ No behavioral issues that result in suspension from school

I further understand that failure to comply may result in withdrawal of permission to attend the West Valley School District.
